Tuesday Evening Mass – 5:30 p.m.

Each Tuesday during Lent a Soup supper will be held immediately following the Mass.

No First Thursday Eucharistic Adoration in April

Anointing Mass

Sunday, March 25, 2012 during 11:30 a.m. Mass

School Penance Service – Thursday, March 22nd at 9:00 a.m.

The traditional laws of **FAST** and **ABSTINENCE** are as follows:

ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY are days of **FAST** and **ABSTINENCE**. **NO** meat, **NO** eating between meals.

FRIDAYS IN LENT are days of **ABSTINENCE**, flesh meat is not to be eaten.

The law of **FAST** applies to those between 18 through 59 years of age. The law of **ABSTINENCE** applies to those over 14 years of age.

Mass at 7:00 p.m. only followed by Eucharistic Adoration until 11:00 p.m.

Good Friday, April 6th

Service with Communion at 2:00 p.m.

Stations of the Cross at 7:00 p.m.

No Friday morning Mass at 8:30 a.m.

Easter Vigil, April 7th

Mass at 8:30 p.m.

No Saturday, 4:00 p.m. Mass

Easter Day, April 8th

Masses at 8:30, 10:00 and 11:30 a.m.

Please note: Confessions will not be heard through the Triduum (April 5th through April 7th)

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
