The Clintonville Resource Center helped **279 individuals in eligible households obtain \$496,056.00** in annual SNAP (food stamp) allotments! In 2010 they also helped 93 people complete 2009 Federal Tax Returns through the OBB and 85 State returns. CRC assisted clients get \$118,000.00 in Federal Tax refunds and \$8,000.00 in State refunds for 2009. That is all money coming back in to our community and helping our neighbors in need.
