Easter Vigil, April 23rd

Mass at 8:30 p.m.

No Saturday, 4:00 p.m. Mass

Easter Day, April 24th

Masses at 8:30, 10:00 and 11:30 a.m. (baptism will take place during 11:30 Mass)

Please note: Confessions will not be heard through the Triduum (April 21st through April 23rd)

The traditional laws of **FAST** and **ABSTINENCE** are as follows:
ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY are days of **FAST** and **ABSTINENCE**. **NO** meat, **NO** eating between meals.

FRIDAYS IN LENT are days of **ABSTINENCE**, flesh meat is not to be eaten.

The law of **FAST** applies to those between 18 through 59 years of age. The law of **ABSTINENCE** applies to those over 14 years of age.
