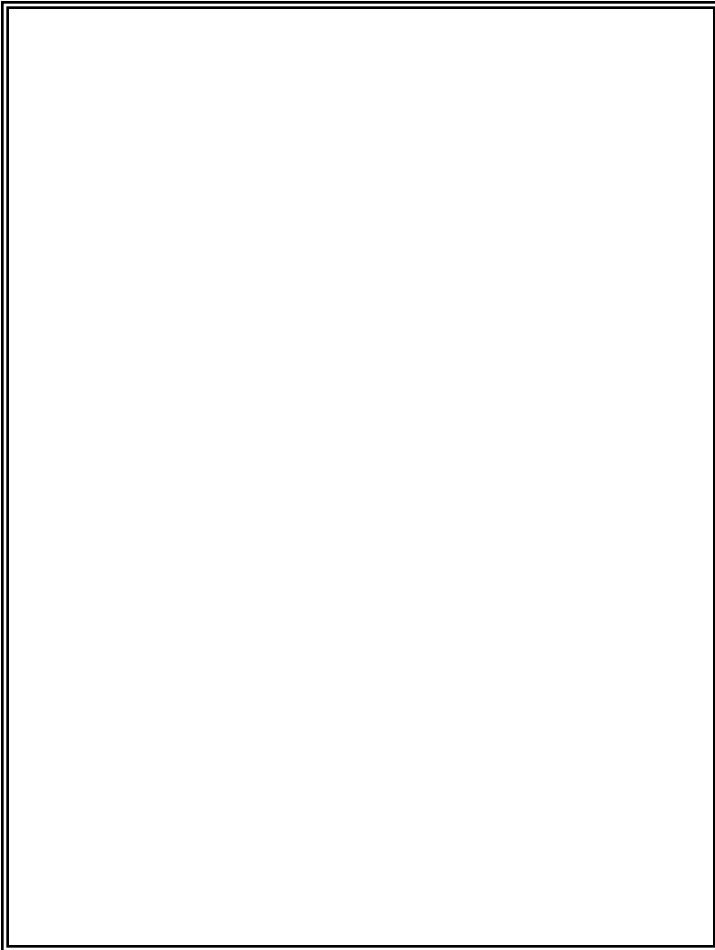

Natural Family Planning classes offered – A five-session series of Natural Family Planning (NFP) classes will begin Wednesday, January 26, 2011, from 7:00-9:00 p.m., at St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Church, 313 North State Street, Westerville. The series will continue 7:00-9:00 p.m., Wednesdays, February 9, 23, March 23, and April 13. The registration fee for the workshop, offered through the Catholic Diocese of Columbus Marriage and Family Life Office, is \$60.00, which includes all instructional materials. Financial assistance is available. NFP is taught by couples who are nationally certified by the Natural Family Planning Program, United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB).
